Chief Brian K. Lee is a 24-year veteran of the D.C. Fire & Emergency Medical Services Department and currently serves as the Assistant Fire Chief of Policy and Standards; in this position, he is responsible for maintaining oversight of the enforcement and regulatory functions of the Department such as Fire Prevention, Internal Affairs, Safety & Wellness, Compliance and Professional Standards. Over the years, he has been assigned to many of the Departments busiest companies including serving in several Special Operations units and holding the position of Special Operations Battalion Chief. In addition, Chief Lee has been elected to various executive positions with the Firefighters union and has the distinction of having served eight years on the Fire & Police Retirement Board, including over two years as Chairman of the \$4 Billion dollar fund.



In 2007, Chief Lee was chosen by Mayor Fenty to serve as the Interim Fire Chief until the arrival of Chief Rubin. He is assigned as a representative for the Department on the City's Consequence Management Team. He has been an instructor of Fire Safety, CPR and Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD). Additionally, Chief Lee is a volunteer with the American Red Cross as a Disaster Team Manager.



Chief Lee's education background include a Bachelor of Arts in Government contracting and procurement from UDC; a Graduate Certificate of Labor Studies from Harvard University and a Master's of Science degree in Fire Executive Leadership from John Hopkins University.
